Some psychologists say that upwards of fifty percent of what people communicate is through body language. Other experts and specialists think it's closer to eighty. And, arguably, when someone's under a huge amount of pressure, where reputation, career and the well-being of family members are at stake, more is conveyed when confronted with criminal wrongdoing and abuse of power impropriety. Whatever the amount is, because of the inter-subjectivity we all share what someone is generally thinking and feeling is easily understood when context is present to inform perceptions.

Some are better at analyzing it than others; like judges for example, who must weigh the credibility of plaintiffs, defendants, the accused and witnesses every day. But you don't have to be that extraordinarily proficient to know when someone's lying, being arrogant, evasive, dismissive or observably uncomfortable.

What's pictorially documented herein are President Obama, Vice-President Biden, secretaries Rice, Rumsfeld and Clinton, CIA Director Panetta, Joint Chiefs Chairman Mullen and others, including spouses, in a diplomatic back-channel where the press and world leaders are compelling them to recall their unlawfulness and improprieties, discovered in March 2011, or are knowledgeable of and trepidatious about the crisis that's gripped Washington since then.
